To the members of the Fir Ëffentlech Bibliothéiken, Lëtzebuerg asbl.

Dear members,

On 25th May 2018, the European General Data Protection Regulation (EU GDPR) entered into force.

Due to your membership in the Fir Ëffentlech Bibliothéiken, Lëtzebuerg asbl., in accordance with Article 10 of the Act of the 21.04.1928 regarding associations and foundations (Loi du 21 avril 1928 sur les associations et les fondations sans but lucratif), we must store your following personal data:

- name;
- residence;
- nationality.

The same article requires us to submit an updated member list every year to the Register of Commerce and Companies (Registre de Commerce et des Sociétés); in accordance with the law this list is free viewable for each person.

We use these personal data for the pursuit of the association goals as well as for the care and administration of the members.

The personal data will be stored in a form that will enable the identification of the concerned persons only for as long as necessary, for the purposes for which they are processed.

The transfer of your personal data to third parties does not occur.

Each club member has the right to:

- Information about the data stored about his person;
- Correction of data if incorrect;
- Blocking of the data, if the correctness is not certain;
- Erasure of the data if the storage was or becomes inadmissible, for example when leaving the association (right to be forgotten);
- Provision of data in a common format (right to data transfer).

If we do not hear from you, we assume that you consent to the use of your data in the manner indicated.
